Safe Families for Children (SFFC) is a ministry of the church to care for children and families in need. Based on Biblical hospitality, SFFC helps equip the church by providing the tools, resources, and training; while also removing the burden of cost and liability.

SFFC is recruiting host families, family friends, and coaches to partner with us in ministry. Host families minister in the convenience of their own home and on their schedules, while also teaching the ministry of Biblical hospitality to their own children. Host families make a huge impact in the lives of

children and families, by truly being Christ's hand and feet. The effects of their service last a lifetime.

Placements are short term and average from a few days to a few weeks. SFFC works with lower risk families to strengthen them early on; and is committed to reunifying families as quickly as possible.

Biblical Hospitality

Biblical hospitality is very different from the occupational role of hospitality. True hospitality is sacrificial, uncomfortable, and does not impress others. It's more about our open heart and home, not our entertaining skills.

The Greek word for hospitality is *philoxenia*, meaning the love

of strangers. (Rom.12:13)
Hospitality shows we love and honor God, by meeting the needs of the poor. (Prov. 14:31) It's to be practiced without grumbling, complaining, or thought of reward. (1 Pet. 4:9) It's the love of strangers, (Heb. 13:1-2), serving widows and orphans (1Tim 5:1-16) caring for the poor and

needy (Luke 14:12-14), and serving the foreigners, immigrants, and refugees (Gen. 18:1-22)

Hospitality is bigger than just meeting the needs of food and shelter. Hospitality seeks to 'minister.'
