

Ms. Ava Johnson and her assistant share with the students how the music industry spends billions of dollars to target minors by “glamorizing” drinking.



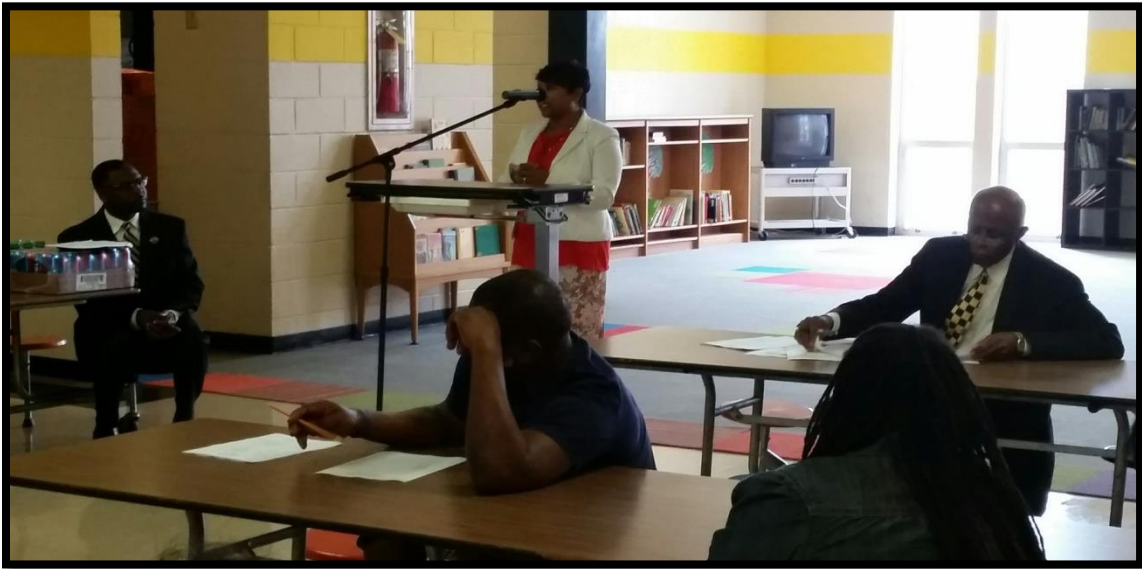

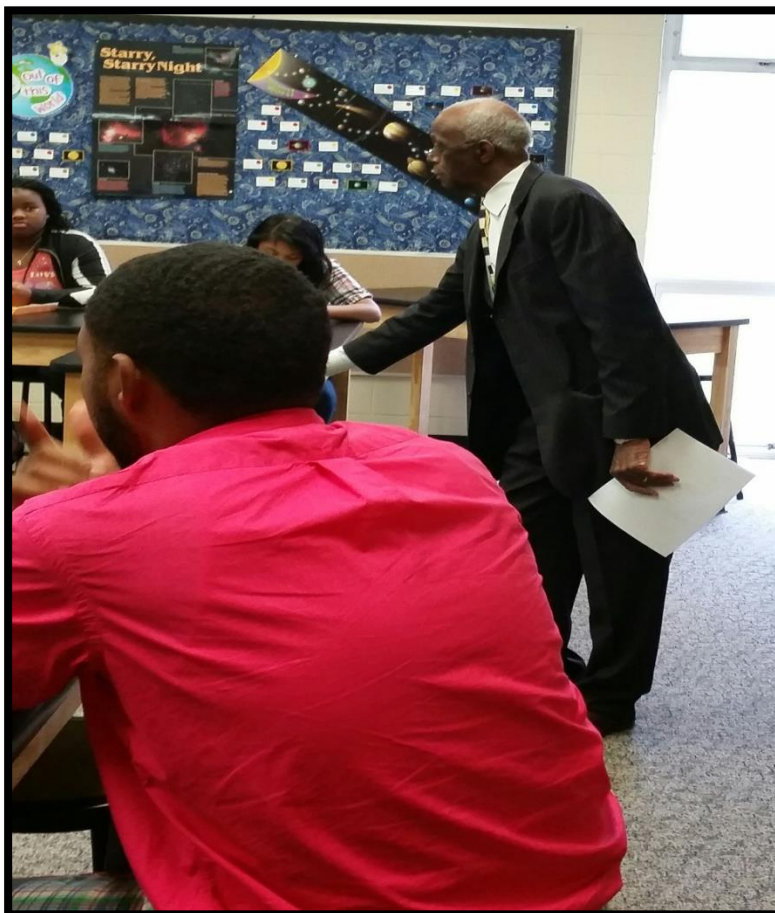
Mayor Jim Thornton was a guest speaker!
